Invocation & Meal Blessing – Rose Window Gala October 26, 2023

What a gathering! Welcome! And thank you for being here! Thank you, Deborah, for the introduction! Thank you, Rebecca, and the Gala Committee members, for making it possible for us to come together for tonight's celebration. Thank you, Bishop Mike, Bishop Gary.
