Archdiocese of San Antonio

After publishing the Report on Child Sexual Abuse by Clergy in the Archdiocese of San Antonio, the Archdiocese received an accusation of sexual misconduct of a minor made against Msgr. Leo Dolan. From 1960-2013 he was assigned in the Archdiocese of San Antonio to St. Paul in San Antonio, to St. Michael in San Antonio, to St. Andrew in Pleasanton, to St. Margaret Mary in San Antonio, to Holy Name in San Antonio, to Mount Sacred Heart School in San Antonio, to St. Benedict in San Antonio, and to St. Helena in San Antonio. According to the person bringing forward this complaint, the alleged abuse took place in the late 1970's.

Msgr. Dolan died on October 23, 2016.
