

POPE PIUS XII



This program is for Boy Scouts and Venturers (male & female) of the Roman or Eastern Catholic faith who have started 9th grade. The purpose of the emblem is to have the candidate examine how being a Christian affects daily life in

the real world, to challenge the candidate to evaluate his/her own personal talents and abilities, and to give the candidate an opportunity to share faith and practice his/her religion among peers while receiving guidance attuned to the ideals of scouting. Their pastor's approval before starting, purchase of the manual, and trained counselor guidance are all required. The program is best conducted in a group setting. After the work is completed, an archdiocesan board of review must interview the scout. The completed application and emblem fee is then sent to the archdiocesan Catholic Committee on Scouting office. It is encouraged that the priest presents the emblem at a parish function. The Boy Scout religious emblem square knot and miniature device be presented at a Pack Meeting. The Boy Scout religious emblem square knot and miniature device may be presented at a Troop Court of Honor.

ST. GEORGE



The National Catholic Committee on Scouting®, acting through the local archdiocese or eparchy, may award the St. George emblem to the laity and clergy, scouters and non-scouters, Catholics and non-Catholics alike, who have made significant and outstanding contributions to the spiritual development of Catholic youth through scouting. The recipients are to be nominated by others and not by self or family members. Service or positions held in the following areas are considered: Spiritual development of Catholic youth in scouting, Boys Scouts of America, Parish and archdiocese (or eparchy), other community (civic, fraternal, etc.) organizations. The bishop will present the award at the annual Catholic Committee on Scouting Mass of Recognition & Banquet. This award entitles the individual to wear the Adult Religious Emblems square knot on his/her uniform.

The average completion time for this program is 3 to 6 months. After the program is completed, the activity book is to be reviewed by the parish priest who meets with the scout to discuss his work. The completed application and emblem fee is then sent to the archdiocesan Catholic Committee on Scouting office. It is encouraged that the priest presents the emblem at a parish function. The Boy Scout religious emblem square knot and miniature device be presented at a Pack Meeting.

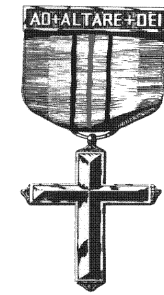
PARVULI DEI

Working on the program in a den or classroom setting is contrary to the purpose of family enrichment in the program. After the work is completed, the activity book is to be reviewed by the parish priest who meets with the scout to discuss his work. The completed application and emblem fee is then sent to the archdiocesan Catholic Committee on Scouting office. It is encouraged that the priest presents the emblem at a parish function. The Boy Scout religious emblem square knot and miniature device may be presented at a Pack Meeting.
