

Thank you for your ongoing support of the Archbishop's Appeal for Ministries. Your leadership is key for the success of this yearly campaign. To celebrate your positive encouragement, I present to you an updated 2022 Archbishop's Appeal for Ministries rebates policy that consists of two-tiered rebates:

**Current rebate policy.** Once your parish has met 20% of parishioner participation based on the number of active registered parishioners, your parish will receive a rebate of \$500. After meeting 25% parishioner participation, your parish will receive a rebate of \$1,000.

The second level of this current rebate policy is awarded when your parish has met its 25% participation and has met or exceeded the 2021 gift average. All funds over this amount will be allocated back for a rebate to your parish.

**Alternative rebate policy.** Once your parish has met 13% of parishioner participation based on the number of active registered parishioners, your parish will receive a rebate of \$1,000. After meeting 18% parishioner participation, your parish will receive a rebate of \$2,000.

The second level of this alternative rebate policy is awarded when your parish has met its 18% participation and has met or exceeded the 2021 gift average. All funds over this amount will be allocated back for a rebate to your parish.

To qualify for the alternative rebate policy, your parish must follow the Archbishop's Appeal for Ministries timeline activities as follow:

- **Celebrate Archbishop's Appeal for Ministry parish activities during the indicated weekends,**
- **Assign an appeal parish coordinator and parish ambassador (s),**
- **Attend an appeal training session,**
- **Show campaign video,**
- **Preach in support of appeal,**
- **Share the invitation to participate from the pulpit,**
- **Have appeal information and donation tools available through all your communication and social media outlets,**
- **Update parishioners and celebrate participation.**

To have a more accurate rebate count for your parish, I encourage you to share an updated contact list of all active parishioners. To accomplish this task, please reach out to Edgar Barroso for directions. Below, you will find a chart with a parish data sample to help you understand these two rebate options.

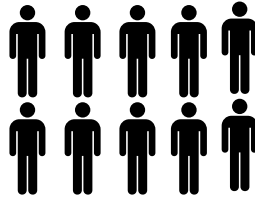
Year average gift 2021
