Continuing Education Credits - Introduction to RCIA

For CE credits from the Institute for Lay Ecclesial Ministry and Service:

There will be a two-page reflection paper requirement to earn 10 CE credits for this *Introduction to the RCIA*. The questions for the reflection paper will be provided at the conclusion of the last session on October 20. There is no partial credit.

This reflection paper must be submitted by Nov. 30, 2021 to be eligible for credit – whether you participated live or watched the session recordings. If you submit a reflection paper by the deadline, you will be informed of your status before the end of the calendar year.

The answers to the questions are to be submitted in a 2-page Word document in 12-pt. font with normal margins. As many as three pages will be accepted. Anything less than 2 pages will not be accepted for credit.

- Q 1. What is the purpose of the RCIA process and what must the team do to help accomplish it?
- Q 2. Why does the Rite put emphasis on a year-round RCIA process? What advantages does it have over one based on a 10-month schedule?
- Q 3. Explain at least three of the Minor Rites of the RCIA. What is the difference between these and the Major Rites?
- Q 4. Why is the Triduum its own liturgical season? Explain why the Easter is considered the "Mother of all Vigils" and is related to the RCIA.
