DISPENSATION FROM CANONICAL FORM Letter to Diocesan Bishop provided By virtue of the norm of canon 1127 §2, the requested dispensation from canonical form is hereby granted. It is not permitted to have two religious marriage services or to have a single service in which both the Catholic and non-Catholic marriage rituals are celebrated Jointly or successively. The prenuptial papers should be filed in the parish from which the application for the dispensation was made. Upon verification that the wedding has taken place, notation is to be made in the marriage register of that parish, and notification is to be given to the parish of the Catholic's baptism.
